COVID Update

We received the following updated guidance yesterday from the Department of Education: Children and young people who are **unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people.**

They can go back to school, college or childcare when **they no longer have a high temperature**, and they are well enough to attend.

Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. **For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.**

This has come into effect today.

So that we can avoid more disruption and staff absence, we will be asking our families and staff to follow this guidance diligently, please. If your child is still unwell after 3 days, please do not send them back to school—especially if they still have a temperature.

If your child develops a temperature in school or becomes unwell, we will be asking you to collect them and keep them at home until they feel better. Thank you so much for respecting these measures and for your continued support.
